People who should consult doctor whether yellow fever vaccination is allowed or not

- Allergic to hen's eggs and/or chicken
- Allergic to pork
- Allergic to gelatin or jelly
- Breast-feeding women
 - You can get vaccinated if you stop breast-feeding just after vaccination, or if you and your breast-fed baby of or older than 9 months get vaccinated simultaneously.
- Patients who are immunocompromised (immunodeficient, have a weakened immune system) because of reasons such as
 - diseases that weakens immune system (e.g., HIV, AIDS)
 - immunosuppressant medication
 - steroid (corticosteroid, adrenocortical hormone)
 - medication for collagen disease
 - (e.g., rheumatoid arthritis, systemic lupus erythematosus, Sjögren's syndrome)
 - anti-cancer agent
 - radiation therapy
- Patients with multiple sclerosis
 - It is known that multiple sclerosis can become worse temporarily after yellow fever vaccination.
- Any other cases that doctor considers the vaccination is inappropriate
